



CALL FOR WORKSHOP PROPOSALS

The 10th EAI International Conference on Ad Hoc Networks

September 20-23, 2018, Cairns, Australia

Overview: The 10th EAI International Conference on Ad Hoc Networks (ADHOCNETS 2018) will be held in Cairns, Australia, on September 20-23, 2018. The conference will offer a four-day technical program including keynotes, technical paper presentations, and workshops. We solicit workshop proposals on emerging hot topics in ad hoc networks. A proposal should focus on a specific theme of current interest and can be half-day or full-day long. Each workshop may include a mix of regular papers and invited presentations that encourage the participation of attendees in active discussions.

What to submit: A proposal can be a maximum of 5 pages long and should clearly identify the theme and specific topics of interest which define the scope of the workshop. Each workshop proposal must include the following information:

1. Title of the workshop
2. Topics of interests
3. List of workshop organizers (name, affiliation, contact information, and a short biography)
4. List of program committee members (name, affiliation, and email address)
5. Duration of the workshop: half-day or full-day
6. Expected numbers of submissions and accepted papers
7. Plan for the review process
8. Draft of Call for Papers
9. Description of the publicity and promotion plan
10. Workshop website (if available)

Note that 8-10 papers are expected for a half-day workshop and 15-20 papers are expected for a full-day workshop.
